

"Life Birds" Added Between Dec. 9, 1941, and June 18, 1945

Although many other bird species were, of course, seen during this period, there were too many to list even if they could all be remembered. I've long since given up keeping a life list, mostly because of being really interested in particular birds, such as endemic species or islanders, those with illustrating altitudinal distribution, ^{spectacular birds,} etc., rather than birds that seemed to be of no particular interest that I've seen but forgotten. The following list, however, is, in a way, part of my own experience, and I do remember most of them* even if I had to be reminded when ^{and where} a good many of them were first seen.
